DID YOU KNOW?

Our online platform is web and app-based and is available on all operating systems.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Download the Premium Wildlife Auctions App available for iOS, Android and Huawei. Click on the button that is relevant to your mobile device or simply scan the QR code with your smart device.

WHAT'S NEW!!

We are thrilled to introduce our latest enhancement, Proxy Bidding! Now you can place proxy bids on auction lots. (Proxy bid - an amount you are willing to pay for the specific lot) Simply place a one-time proxy bid on a lot, and our system will automatically manage subsequent bidding on your behalf. It's a hassle - free way to stay competitive in the auction.

DIFFERENT TYPE AUCTIONS

The Premium Wildlife Auctions platform provides you with 3 options to host your auction.

1. **Live Auction** - This is your traditional way of hosting an auction where the auctioneer closes the auction lot for lot with an audience. This method allows the bidder to bid online via live streaming in real-time or live on the floor at the auction. A countdown timer on the app indicates to the online bidder that final bids have to be placed before the auctioneer then closes the lot after the timer has run out.
2. **Livestream Auction** - Livestream auctions do not differ a lot from a Live Auction. There will be an auctioneer who still closes the auction lot for lot via Livestream, but no audience is involved at the auction. Bidding will only be done by telephone bidding or online bidding. The same principle for the countdown timer applies to a Livestream Auction.
3. **Timed Auction/Flash Sale** - This is purely an online auction. There is no auctioneer involved as it is a platform-based auction. Lots close in staggered intervals starting from a specific time and remain open for an undisclosed duration depending on the activity of each lot. There is a two-minute rule that applies. This simply means that when a bid is placed in the final 2 minutes before the lots closing time, the timer will extend by another 2 minutes to prevent bidders from losing out and to keep the bidding transparent and fair.

ONLINE AUCTION REGISTRATION PROCESS

The process to register online for any of the above-mentioned auction types remains the same. Simply create a user profile (one time only!) and click on "Register to bid" for the relevant auction. You will receive a unique bidder number. Simply collect your bidder card from the registration table should you attend the auction. No paper, no scans, no waiting in line!

DNA - MITOCHONDRIAL & NUCLEAR

A NOTE FROM PROFESSOR BETTINE VAN VUUREN:

Mitochondria are cellular organelles, outside the nucleus, and are responsible for energy generation in cells. The mitochondrial DNA is inherited through the maternal lineage, with no contribution from the father. Mitochondrial DNA is therefore a good marker to trace female lineages, and provides information about the historical origin of lineages. It can also be used to trace the number of family lineages in a specific area or population. It is the equivalent of male surname transmission in humans. Nuclear DNA is in the nucleus of cells. It contains coding and non-coding DNA, and is packaged as chromosomes (in antelope, there are typically 60 chromosomes per cell). Nuclear DNA is passed on from both the mother and father; with an offspring related to each parent by 50%, (full siblings are related to one another by 50%). Nuclear DNA provides valuable information about parentage and relatedness, and reflects the membership of a specific individual to different genetic groups (i.e., whether an individual is admixed, or pure within a specific genetic group). Mitochondrial and nuclear DNA, either singly or in combination, provide valuable information that can assist in the selection process. Various strategies present themselves, but it is crucial that the breeder makes a decision early on in the selection process, and then adheres to it throughout the breeding program; otherwise, there will not be any real progress towards a specific end goal. For example, a breeder may decide that high levels of genetic diversity and variation is crucial in the management of specific herds. It would then be important to maximize the different lineages included in the breeding core, which would include animals from across the range of the species. A typical nuclear result may take the form of 20% Eastern, 50% Zambian, 30% Southern, with mitochondrial membership to any of the genetic groups. At the other side of the breeding-strategy spectrum, a breeder may decide on pure populations. Here, the mitochondrial result will indicate the historical origin of the maternal lineage, while the nuclear result should indicate membership within only a single genetic group, preferably the same group as the mitochondrial result. A typical result may take the form of 90% Zambian, with mitochondrial membership also in the Zambian, or Wes Zambian group (indicating a pure Zambian, or Wes Zambian animal). All, or the overriding majority of animals in the core breeding group, should follow these results. It is important that breeder keep in mind that some calves may show unexpected membership to non-selected groups. This is common and it reflects ancestral polymorphisms, also known as old blood. A grandparent, or even great grandparent, may have had membership to a different group (this is natural, and we even see these results in wild animals naturally occurring in areas).

Acquiring Sable females was very difficult, & finding high-quality females or males was even more challenging. We held each Sable to strict benchmarks, including confirmation, solid feet, prolificacy, calm temperament, & impressive horns. Achieving these standards took us 10 years & involved evaluating numerous Sable. Establishing that solid herd paid off immensely for the events that followed. In 2015, I learned that a West Zambian Sable Bull in Africa, Mopanie, had sold for \$1.96 million dollars. This inspired me to try to locate West Zambian Sable in the US. In 2018, I acquired our first West Zambian genetics, a Bull, we call "Z-Man". Today, every Sable Antelope on Palahala Ranch carries West Zambian DNA. We now have the largest genetic pool of West Zambian DNA in the US, consisting of at least 4 different maternal lines & 6 of the only known Mitochondrial West Zambians in the US. Palahala Ranch Sable can enhance any breeding program that is wanting to grow big Sable, while contributing genetic diversity & vigor to produce healthier, stronger Sable. The West Zambian Sable are having world record results in South Africa, making them an advantageous addition to the Sable Antelope community in the US.

JUANELEE

Juanelee is an 11-year-old girl from Mason, TX. Her life as a normal child changed dramatically in February 2024.



Juanelee suddenly fell ill. The first diagnosis was pneumonia, but she could not recover and get better; this resulted in further testing.

Admitted to the PICU on March 5th due to a mass in her chest, Juanelee underwent a lumbar puncture and bone marrow biopsy, confirming leukemia, although the specific subtype remained uncertain. Commencing chemotherapy on the 6th, she has been battling severe nausea and inability to retain food. It wasn't until March 11th that the diagnosis of T-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic

Leukemia was conclusively determined. A grueling three-year chemotherapy regimen started, accompanied by weekly visits to the Dell Children's Hospital in Austin, Texas for specialized care.

Within two weeks of receiving chemotherapy and steroid treatments, they started noticing physical changes. She struggled to move around and with every movement, she was in pain. Just as she started feeling better, she faced another obstacle and began experiencing hair loss, a distressing reminder of the challenges she faces. By the end of the first three weeks, she had lost all of her hair.

Since the diagnosis, she has been hospitalized on three different occasions, as a result of the low counts caused by chemotherapy and due to her immune system that was wiped out and non-resistant to any viruses.

Throughout her treatment and with each round of chemotherapy, there have been some challenges that she had to face. Every day is different, but she is very positive and never backs down. There is still a long road to recovery ahead, but with the support that she has been receiving from family, friends and the wonderful community of Mason, we know that she can get through this!

Lian Verwey is a remarkable 10-year-old boy from Mason, Texas, who lights up every room he enters with his contagious smile and joyful spirit. Lian, the son of Ryno & Mandy Verwey, was born with a rare genetic condition called Chromosome 3q13 Deletion Syndrome, but his story is one of perseverance & triumph.

Despite being told he might never walk or talk, Lian has defied the odds, achieving milestones that many thought impossible.
